Bylaws Changes Regarding Officer Nominations and Election Process are Now in Effect

The membership voted and approved the Bylaws changes at the 2019 annual meeting at Sandestin in June as approved by the Board of Governors and recommended by the Long Range Planning Committee regarding the officer nominations and election process. The highlights of the changes include moving from a two candidate ballot to a single candidate, extending the time frame for the membership to submit candidate recommendations to the nominating committee, expanding the nominating committee, and removing floor nominations at the annual meeting. The Bylaws resolution can be found on the MSCPA website on the Policies and Bylaws web page.

Qualifications for Candidacy

In order to support the Bylaws changes, Nominating Committee Policies were also approved. These are to provide guidelines for the committee to ensure the most comprehensive consideration process under the single candidate process.

The qualifications of each candidate shall be considered by the Nominating Committee. While neither the MSCPA Bylaws for the Nominating Committee Policies call for a specific minimum qualification for each position, the Nominating Committee will provide an increased level of consideration to those candidates with the following history of Society involvement:

- Previous service as Secretary or Treasurer of the Board of Directors
- Previous Board of Directors service in a non-officer capacity
- Committee Chairman or Committee Millennial Chairman
- Positions held as a Young CPA Network officer or on the Young CPA Network Board of Directors
- Positions held within Chapter(s)
- Committee membership
- Other involvement or service to the Society

All decisions of the Nominating Committee shall be settled by majority vote, in accordance with the MSCPA Bylaws.

The Mississippi Society of CPAs, Boards of Accountancy and Others Unite to Maintain Public Protection as Licensing Standards Put at Risk

The Mississippi Society of CPAs (MSCPA) has announced its support for the Alliance for Responsible Professional Licensing (ARPL) - a new coalition of advanced professions focused on educating policymakers and the public about the importance of rigorous professional licensing standards.

The MSCPA will support AICPA and NASBA and other ARPL members as they seek to educate and inform lawmakers around the country of the need to maintain standards for highly complex, technical professions like the CPA profession that have a clear impact on the public's fiscal health and welfare. The coalition was formed to ensure the voices and concerns of the advanced professions are heard amid the growing debate around licensing.

Karen Moody, President and CEO of the MSCPA states, "ARPL fills a critical need in bringing a unique perspective to this debate. ARPL will represent our concerns and bring this critical perspective to the larger debate while carrying this message in our state."

"Weakening professional licensing standards on a state-by-state basis will destroy the confidence in qualifications and completely disrupt existing mobility models for advanced professions like ours," warned Barry Melancon, CPA, CGMA, President and CEO of AICPA. "Employers will be less inclined to accept out-of-state licenses if some states have rigorous requirements and others have weak requirements. The result: it will become more difficult for CPAs to move and maintain their careers across states."



A Fiscal Reality: MSCPA and AICPA Support the Fiscal State of the Nation Resolution

The U.S. government's balance sheet indicates that, over time, the nation had an accumulated deficit (from annual shortfalls) of \$21.5 trillion as of September 30, 2018. To put that in perspective, if you made a stack of 21.5 trillion \$1 bills, you would be able to go to the moon and back more than three times.


Recently, Representatives Kathleen Rice (D-N.Y.) and Andy Barr (R-K.Y.) introduced the Fiscal State of the Nation resolution, H. Con. Res. 68, with 103 additional co-sponsors. It provides "for a joint hearing of the Committees on the Budget of the House of Representatives and the Senate to receive a presentation from the Comptroller General of the United States regarding the audited financial statement of the executive branch." The resolution ensures that members of Congress are made aware of the information in the federal financial statements and helps them to better understand how current and/or future policy may affect the nation's long-term fiscal health.

"We thank Representatives Rice, Barr and the more than 100 other members who signed on to this important resolution," said MSCPA President/CEO Karen Moody. "Their leadership will help ensure that key policymakers are focused on some of the most important aspects of the consolidated

financial statements, including financial and stability measures. The Society is encouraging each Mississippi Member of the U.S. House to also support this resolution by becoming a co-signer."

AICPA also supports the Fiscal State of the Nation resolution. The profession believes that the consolidated federal financial statements and the Government Accountability Office (GAO)'s audit report provide valuable information on the financial condition of the federal government, and that policymakers should consider this information while making key decisions.

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


