

The Top 10 Excuses That Keep You From Being Great

One word kicks this excuse in the teeth: "Google."

Put yourself on a schedule, structure your day, and get more rest. If necessary (and possible) take naps so you can remain productive.


If you're chronically tired, improve your diet and make time more exercise. Productivity creates energy.

Thank you to the Young CPA Board and Conference Chairman, Noah Davis, for planning such a great event.


